### The journey

During the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, Hidalgo County officials obtained federal funds to help provide free high-speed internet access to some of the county's neediest residents. The county allocated more than \$15 million to deploy the CommScope RUCKUS smart mesh Wi-Fi network that included 3,400 access points (APs) in four zones.

RUCKUS partnered with SmartWave Technologies and Insight Enterprises to complete the project on an ambitious timeline. While a deployment of this magnitude would normally take two to three years, RUCKUS and its technology partners cut the time down to about a year.

"I think the pandemic probably accelerated things from a cooperation perspective," says John Brooks network services director for Insight Enterprises, a CommScope RUCKUS technology partner. "Everyone came together for a good cause. We had a great subcontractor, a great manufacturer and a great extended customer family."

## The solution

SmartWave Technologies deployed RUCKUS outdoor APs using a smart mesh wireless network. This allowed for far fewer APs than is possible with other solutions. The small footprint allowed Hidalgo County to maximize its existing infrastructure and savings.
